Starting Location and Time: Darden Towe Park (1:45 PM)

Ending Location and Time: Riverview Park (3:45 PM)

Weather: Mostly Sunny Recent Precipitation: One large rain this week

Land Use:

Residential mainly, with some commercial use and park property

Wildlife Sightings and Plant Life:

Turtles, Geese, Ducks, Small Birds, Herons. Some fall colors remain on trees, but a lot of leaves have fallen from the trees by now. One large tree down in the River at 1st large rapids downstream from Free Bridge.

People Interactions:

Saw several people at Darden Towe Park and Riverview Park enjoying the trails and water, but no other boaters out today.

Litter and Pollution:

Collected a few pieces of smaller trash today.

Overall Summary:

The recent rain storm meant the water level and flow were up from the past few months, but still shallow in most parts and pretty calm. Beautiful day to be out on the Rivanna – especially for this time of year! Saw many Herons and Turtles during the paddle. See photo below of new River water level gauge Chris Gensic from Charlottesville Park & Rec recently painted on Free Bridge abutment. The Landscape Spreader previously reported near Riverview Park was not seen during the paddle today.

Actions Needed – level of priority (1 highest/5 lowest):

4 – Determine if there is any reason for concern regarding the new rip rap installed at private property just upstream from Darden Towe Boat Ramp.
